- iii) to treat their Dental College on par with Government Dental Colleges;
- iv) to permit them to adopt the fee structure as prescribed for the students admitted to Government Dental Colleges in the State.

Accordingly they have requested the Government to modify the conditions 1 to 4 imposed in the G.O. third read above.

3. The Government after a careful examination of the matter have recommended to the Government of India for exemption of the Army College of Dental Sciences, Secunderabad from the provisions of Presidential Order, 1974. The Government of India in their letter 7th read above have communicated the A.P. Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admissions) (Amendment) Order, 1999 in which the courses of study at the Army College of Dental Sciences located at Secunderabad have been exempted from the provisions of A.P. Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admissions) Order, 1974 as published in the Gazette of India in their Notification No. S.O. 21 (E) Ministry of Home Affairs, dated 18th January, 1999.

4. The Government have further examined the issue of exemption of Army College of Dental Sciences, Secunderabad, from the provisions of A.P. Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admissions into Under-Graduate Professional Courses through Common Entrance Test) Rules, 1993 issued in the G.O. 1st read above and also to treat this College on par with Government Dental Colleges, duly taking into consideration the judgements of the Supreme Court of India in the reference second read above.

5. After careful examination of the matter and in modification of the conditions 1 to 4 imposed in para 3 of the G.O. 3rd read above, the Government hereby exempt the Army College of Dental Sciences, Secunderabad from the provisions of A.P. Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admissions into Under-Graduate Professional courses through Common Entrance Test) Rules, 1993 subject to the following conditions:

- 1) that the admissions into the Army College of Dental Sciences, Secunderabad shall be governed by the Entrance Test conducted by the Army College of Dental Sciences for the purpose and the allotment of seats shall be on the basis of merit obtained in the said Entrance Test.
- 2) that the Army College of Dental Sciences, Secunderabad shall be treated on par with Government Dental Colleges in the State and they should charge the fees as prescribed by the Government of Andhra Pradesh for the Government Dental Colleges from time to time;
- 3) that the State Government will not give any grant-in-aid to the Army College of Dental Sciences, Secunderabad;

- 4) that the Army College of Dental Sciences shall follow the age and educational qualifications etc.. as prescribed by the Dental Council of India from time to time;
  - 5) that out of 40 seats, the Army College of Dental Sciences shall reserve 6 (six) seats in favour of the Government of Andhra Pradesh for allotment to the students of Andhra Pradesh State based on merit obtained in the EAMCET;
  - 6) that the unfilled seats, if any, should be surrendered to the Government of Andhra Pradesh for allotment basing on the merit in EAMCET;
6. Orders regarding issue of amendment to relevant rules issued in G.O.Ms.No.184, Education (EC.II) Department, dated 20-8-1993 for exemption of Army College of Dental Sciences, Secunderabad will be issued separately.

Notwithstanding, the disaffiliation of the colleges specified in:-

- Schedule C - Colleges of Nursing

- Schedule E - Colleges of Homoeopathy
- Schedule F - Colleges of Unani
- Schedule G - Colleges of Naturopathy
- Schedule H - Colleges of MLT
- Schedule I - Colleges of Physiotherapy
- Schedule J - Colleges of Nutrition and Public Health
- Schedule K - Research Institutions offering Ph.D and Post Doctor Fellowship Courses




#### ORDER:-

In the letter 2<sup>nd</sup> read above, Government have issued Essentiality Certificate for starting of Post Graduate Dental Courses at Army College of Dental Sciences, Secunderabad in four specialities with an intake capacity of 7 seats.

2. In the letter 3<sup>rd</sup> read above, the Principal, Army College of Dental Sciences, Secunderabad, has stated that the Government of India have permitted them to introduce P.G. in Prosthodontics with two seats in 2008-2009 and hence requested the Government to issue necessary orders on the seat matrix, as well as fee structure in respect of students of P.G. Dental courses of ACDS, Secunderabad.

3. The Government after careful examination and in consultation with the Director of Medical Education hereby issue the following instructions to the Principal, Army College of Dental Sciences, Secunderabad for making admissions of P.G. MDS courses:-

1. The seat sharing matrix in P.G. Dental Courses shall be similar to that of G.O.Ms. No.87, HM&FW(E1) Dept., dated 19.2.1999, wherein 85% seats are reserved for the students of ACDS / Wards of Army Personnel to be filled by ACDS and 15% of seats are reserved for the State Government of A.P., in which case, the first five years both seats of MDS course in the speciality of Prosthodontics already permitted by the Government of India, will be filled by the ACDS, Secunderabad, and every sixth year one seat will be available to the competent authority on behalf of the State Government and one seat will be filled by the ACDS, Secunderabad.
2. The Entrance exams and admissions shall be on the lines of G.O.Ms. No.87, HM&FW(E1) Dept., dated 19-2-1999, wherein ACDS has the freedom to conduct its own entrance exam and admissions after getting formal permission from Government of India.

4 The Principal, Army College of Dental Sciences, Secunderabad shall take further necessary action accordingly.



3. In the Government Order third read above, the Government have issued Rules for Admission into Under Graduate Professional Courses in Medical and Dental in Un-Aided Non-Minority Professional Institutions in the State, from the Academic year 2004-05.

4. In the letter forth read above, the Brigadier, Cdr Andhra Sub Area, Army College of Dental Sciences, Secunderabad has stated that in G.O.Ms. No. 57, it was mentioned that the Government have issued orders treating the Army Dental College on par with Government Colleges and to charge fees as for the Government rate without any grant-in-aid to the institution.
