



1. Distribution of study subjects based on the knowledge of the teacher on the subject.




2. Distribution of study subjects based on clarity and understandability of teacher's explanation.





3. Distribution of study subjects based on teachers approach to teaching.




 Distribution of study subjects based on coverage of syllabus by teachers as prescribed by the university.




 Distribution of study subjects based on the percentage of teachers usage of ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching.

What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching?


 Distribution of study subjects based on institutions provision on multiple opportunities to learn and grow.






7. Distribution of study subjects based on teachers identification on students strength and encourage them by providing right level of challenges.




8. Distribution of study subjects based on teachers identification on students weaknesses and help to overcome them.




 Distribution of study subjects based on weather institution encourages students to participate in extracurricular activities.




10. Distribution of study subjects based on efforts made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make students ready for the world of work.

OUTCOME OF STUDENT SATISFACTORY SURVEY

Student satisfactory survey: SSS was conducted among ACDS students from

1st year to Post graduates (total approx 156 students) in January 2020. The outcome is as below.

- 1. Knowledge on the subject:-50% of the students responded that teacher's explanation is good at knowledge on the subjects.
- 2. Clarity and understanding ability: 50% responded good
- 3. Approach to teaching: 50% responded good
- 4. Syllabus:- More than 60% teachers cover the entire syllabus prescribed by the university
- 5.Use of ICT tools:-Nearly 70% teachers incorporate ICT tools as their teaching methods
- 6. Oppurtunities to learn and grow:- Nearly 40% students strongly agree
- 7.Identification of strength and weakness:-37% teacher's identify student's strength and 32% teacher's identify student's weaknesses.
- 8. Participation in extracurricular activities: More than 50% agree that institution encourages students to participate in extracurricular activities.
- 9.Efforts to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills:-Nearly 40% of the students responded moderately.
