IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR ADMISSION TO BDS COURSE - 2021

▶ The admission will be strictly on UG NEET merit ranking, based on marks obtained in NEET UG-2021 (Exam date 01 Aug 2021).

▶ **ACDS has an intake of 40 students per year. Out of these 40 seats, Six seats are for Telangana State and 34 seats are for wards of serving/ retired Army personnel. The admission for all the 34 ACDS Management Quota Seats will be carried out by KNR Univ of Health Sciences (KNR UHS) only. KNR UHS will issue two separate notifications for Registration in their Web site. First notification will be for Competent Authority Quota for Six BDS seats of Telangana State. Army Candidates must not (MUST NOT) register themselves under Competent Authority Quota as it is only for Telangana State Civilians. If you register under this quota you are automatically debarred from Registering for the 34 Army seats under Management Quota. Thereafter, notification for Admission into BDS Course Management Quota i.e., for 34 seats for wards of serving & retired Army personnel in ACDS and for others in Management Quota of Private Non Aided Non-Minority & Minority Colleges is generally issued after the last date of registration for Competent Authority Quota. Candidates desiring admission under Army Quota in ACDS should register for Management Quota Seats in ACDS.**

▶ Candidates have to register online in KNR UHS website (www.knr.uhs.in) by paying required Registration Fee for attending the Counselling Session for admission to ACDS for 34 seats under Category B Management seats.

▶ After successful Registration, the candidate will be automatically issued an online Acknowledgement Form with Registration Number by the University.

GENERAL INFORMATION

THE COLLEGE

1. Army College of Dental Sciences, Secunderabad has been established under the aegis of Army Welfare Education Society as a Centre of Excellence for Dental education. The College aims at imparting a high standard of dental education coupled with the development of good moral character for the children of regular Army personnel/regular Army pensioners and war widows. Army College of Dental Sciences, Secunderabad is affiliated to Kaloji Narayana Rao University of Health Sciences, Warangal(Telangana). The College has been Recognized by the Dental Council of India and Ministry of Health & Family Welfare vide their letter No V.12017/4/2021-DE dated 19 Apr 2021 for an intake of 40 students annually.

2. The Army College of Dental Sciences is **Private Un-Aided & Non-Minority Educational Institution.**

COURSE AND SEATS

3. The College offers the course leading to award of degree of '**Bachelor of Dental Surgery**' by Kaloji Narayana Rao University of Health Sciences, Warangal (Telangana). The duration of the course is four years of active study plus twelve months of Compulsory Rotatory Internship. PG courses in the departments of Pedodontics & Preventive Dentistry, Orthodontics & Dentofacial Orthopedics, Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery, Prosthodontics and Crown & Bridge, Conservative Dentistry & Endodontics and Periodontology also have commenced several years back.

CAMPUS AND HOSTEL

4. The campus is self-contained with hostel, sports fields and other amenities. It is well connected by city Bus Service (211M from Secunderabad Station) with Secunderabad and Hyderabad cities, Railway Stations and Airport. Separate hostels have been constructed for boys and girls and experienced wardens ensure efficient functioning. The students will be provided with all facilities in the hostel to make them feel 'at home' so that they can focus on academics. Spacious dining halls with modern cooking amenities have been provided to ensure hygienic food to the students. Hostel stay is compulsory for all students and students are not permitted to stay outside under own arrangements. Lodging and messing expense will be borne by the students.

LIBRARY

5. A well-stocked library with technical textbooks, reference books and journals, Newspapers, Magazines and general books are available for use by students. Internet and photo copying facilities are available in the Library.

HEALTH & RECREATIONAL FACILITIES

6. (a) Excellent games, sports and health club facilities are available to promote sports and health activities.
- (b) The ACDS campus is self-contained in recreational facilities and amenities such as auditorium, Gymnasium, Cafeteria and CSD outlet.
- (c) MI Room facilities are available on the campus under a trained Nurse. Sick students, are referred to MH Secunderabad whenever required. Dependency certificates/ECHS card details should be submitted to ACDS by all parents at the time of admission of their children.

ADMISSION CRITERIA

7. Admission to the first year of the BDS degree course at the Army College of Dental Sciences, Secunderabad for 34 seats is reserved for the wards of Army/retired Army personnel and remaining 06 seats reserved for KNR UHS Convener Quota for the State of Telangana. All 40 seats will be filled based on UG NEET 2021 Merit through Counseling conducted by Kaloji Narayana Rao University of Health Sciences in Hyderabad.

8. Candidates will be initially granted PROVISIONAL admission. Their admission will be considered final only after acceptance of eligibility by Kaloji Narayana Rao University of Health Sciences, Warangal (Telangana).

9. The college management reserves its right to deny admission to any student in the event the admission is found to be irregular or violating any rules and/or regulations framed under any statute or statutes.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE STUDENTS TO ENSURE THAT THEY ARE ELIGIBLE FOR ADMISSION IN ALL ASPECTS

10. **Eligibility For Admission To ACDS** - The admission to ACDS is for dependent children of eligible serving Army Personnel, eligible ex Army personnel and war widows of the Army. The children of following categories of Army personnel are eligible and they are required to submit the relevant certificate as given against the category applicable to them as proof of their eligibility for admission to ACDS on the day of Counselling by KNR UHS :-

- (a) The applicants must fall into one of the following categories: -
- (i) Children of serving Army personnel with minimum 10 years continuous service in the Army (**Submit Certificate No 1**).
 - (ii) Children of ex Army personnel granted/awarded regular pension, liberalized family pension, family pension or disability pension at the time of their superannuation, demise, discharge, release medical board/invalided medical board. This includes wards of recruits medically boarded and granted disability pension (**Submit Certificate No 1**).
 - (iii) Children of ex Army personnel who have taken discharge or released after ten years of service (**Submit Certificate No 1**).
- (b) **Adopted/Step children and children of Remarried Widows**
- (i) Adopted Child of Army personnel if adopted at least five years prior to seeking admission. (**Submit Certificate No .2**).
 - (ii) Step Children are eligible provided they are born from a wedding where at least one parent belonged to the Army who is other wise eligible. (**Submit Certificate No.2**)
- (c) **Eligibility Criteria in Special Cases**
- (i) **Eligibility Criteria for wards of Ex Army Medical Corps Officers/Army Dental Corps Officers presently serving with Indian Navy or Indian Air Force(IN/IAF)**. Wards of only those ex Army medical officers/Army Dental Corps officers presently serving with Indian Navy or Indian Air Force who have served with the Army for at least 10 years (**Submit Certificate No.3**).
 - (ii) **Eligibility Criteria for Children of APS/MNS/TA Personnel (Submit Certificate No.3)**
 - (aa) Children of APS Personnel classified as ex servicemen as per Govt. of India, Ministry of Defence letter No 9 (52)/88D (Res) dated 19 Jul 1989.

(ab) Children of those APS personnel who are on deputation and who have put in 10 years of service in the Army.

(ac) Children of APS personnel, who are directly recruited into APS who have completed 10 years of service and of those who as per their terms and conditions of service, retired from APS without reversion to P&T Department after completing their minimum pensionable service of which 10 years was in the Army.

(ad) Children of only those members of MNS who have 10 years service as regular members of MNS or are in receipt of pension from the Army.

(ae) Children of only those TA Personnel who have completed 10 years of embodied service.

Note: - 1) The management reserves the right to include any other eligibility Criteria from time to time in addition to the above.

(2) Unrecognized certificates as per Govt. of India rules are not valid. The Pre-University certificate issued by Janardhan Rai Nagar, Rajasthan Vidyapeeth (Deemed) University, Rajasthan state is not valid.

Note : Definition of dependent children : Children are not dependent if they attain the following :-

(a) **Sons.** Attaining 25 years of age as on 31 Dec 2021 or employment whichever is earlier.

(b) **Daughters.** On marriage or employment whichever is earlier.

11. Physical Fitness. The candidate should be certified by MH/Authorized Medical Attendant to be in a state of good physical and mental health to pursue the course. A certificate to this effect as per the enclosed form (Certificate No 4) is required to be submitted by the candidate at the time of admission.

12. Educational Qualifications & Eligibility Criteria. No Candidate shall be allowed to be admitted to the Dental Curriculum of first Bachelor of Dental Surgery (BDS) Course until :-

(a) He/she shall complete the age of 17 years on or before 31st December, of the year of admission to the BDS course

(b) He/She has qualified in NEET(UG) 2021.

(c) He/she has passed qualifying examination as under:-

(i) The higher secondary examination or the Indian School Certificate Examination which is equivalent to 10+2 Higher Secondary Examination after a period of 12 years study, the last two years of study comprising of Physics, Chemistry, Biology(Botany, Zoology)/Bio Technology and other elective subjects with English at a level not less than the core course for English as prescribed by the NCERT after the introduction of the 10+2+3 years educational structure as

recommended by the National Committee on education; Note: Where the course content is not as prescribed for 10+2 education structure of the National Committee, the candidates will have to undergo a period of one year pre-professional training before admission to ACDS.

or

(ii) The intermediate examination in science of an Indian University/Board or other recognized examining body with Physics, Chemistry and Biology/ Bio technology which shall include a practical test in these subjects and also English as a compulsory subject.

or

(iii) The pre-professional/pre-medical examination with Physics, Chemistry and Biology/ Bio technology, after passing either the higher secondary school examination, or the pre-university or an equivalent examination. The pre-professional/pre-medical examination shall include a practical test in Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Bio Technology and also English as a compulsory subject

or

(iv) The first year of the three years degree course of a recognized university, with Physics, Chemistry and Biology/ Bio Technology including a practical test in three subjects provided the examination is a "University Examination" and candidate has passed 10+2 with English at a level not less than a core course.

or

(v) B.Sc examination of an Indian University, provided that he/she has passed the B.Sc examination with not less than two of the following subjects Physics, Chemistry, Biology (Botany, Zoology)/ Bio Technology and further that he/she has passed the earlier qualifying examination with the following subjects- Physics, Chemistry, Biology/ Bio Technology and English.

or

(vi) Any other examination which, in scope and standard is found to be equivalent to the intermediate science examination of an Indian University/Board, taking Physics, Chemistry and Biology/ Bio Technology including practical test in each of these subjects and English.

(vii) Must have passed in subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Bio Technology & English individually and must have obtained minimum 50% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry, Biology/ Bio Technology at the qualifying examination and must have passing marks in English.

(viii) Furthermore, study of Biology/ Bio Technology as an additional subject at 10+2 level also shall not be eligible for admission. Candidates who have passed 10+2 from Open schools or as a private candidate are also not eligible.

(ix) The candidate should be medically fit.

13. Minimum Aggregate. He/She must have passed in the subjects individually and must have obtained a minimum of 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology taken together as one and in the same sitting. Compartmental Pass candidates are not eligible for admission.

14. Ensuring Eligibility. Ensuring that a candidate fulfills all conditions/qualifications for eligibility in the BDS Course is the responsibility of the candidate. The eligibility of the candidate will be verified by the ACDS and KNRUHS at the time of admission and also

later during scrutiny of papers by the University. If a candidate is found to be ineligible at any stage during the entire process, the college reserves the right to cancel his/her candidature.

24. **Provisional Admission.** All admissions made by ACDS are provisional. An admission will be considered final only when the eligibility criteria are met and the admission of the candidate to the course is confirmed by the University. The rules and regulations of Kaloji Narayana Rao University of Health Sciences, Warangal (Telangana) shall apply to all admission procedures.

FEES AND REFUNDS

FEES FOR BDS COURSE

25. The fees indicated below is for the first year only. The college being a private, unaided, non-minority institution shall be entitled to vary the fees from time to time and year to year, and the fee structure from year to year shall be binding on students seeking admission to the first year of four years BDS course and one year Compulsory Rotatory Internship:-

(a) First Year

(i)	Tuition Fee and Allied charges	:	Rs 3,15,000.00

26. Mode of Payment

(a) **Option I** : Complete payment of Rs **3,87,400/-** as onetime payment. Payments must be made through following demand drafts and must be produced at the time of KNR UHS counselling for admission into ACDS:-

(i) Tuition Fee and Allied charges incl Refundable Security deposit (Rs 3,55,000/-) DD for Rs 3,55,000/- to be prepared in favour of Army College of Dental Sciences (Main A/c) payable at SECUNDERABAD or HYDERABAD or can be paid through Net Banking (Q Fix) at the time of admission also.

(ii) Hostel Fee Rs 32,400/- DD for RS 32,400/- to be prepared in favour of Army College of Dental Sciences (Hostel/Mess A/c) payable at SECUNDERABAD or HYDERABAD or can be paid through Net Banking (Q Fix) at the time of admission also.

(b) Option II : In Two Installments

(i) First installment (at the time of counselling)

(aa) Tuition Fee and Allied charges incl Refundable Security deposit. DD for Rs 2,55,000/- to be prepared in favour of Army College of Dental Sciences (Main A/c) payable at SECUNDERABAD or HYDERABAD or can be paid through Net Banking(Q Fix) at the time of admission also.

(ab) Hostel fee DD for RS 32,400/- to be prepared in favour of Army College of Dental Sciences (Hostel/Mess A/c) payable at SECUNDERABAD or HYDERABAD or can be paid through Net Banking (Q Fix) at the time of admission also.

(ii) Second Installment (on or before 31 Oct 2021) : Rs 1,00,000/-
(Demand draft to be prepared in favour of Army College of Dental Sciences (Main A/c).

(c) In addition to the above, fee for the following charges have to be paid by the students on yearly basis:-

(i) **Mess Charges.** The students Mess is run by a Mess Committee formed by students amongst themselves. Monthly messing is approximately Rs 3000/- (approx Rs 100/- per day) or actual as worked out by the Mess Committee. Payment for one year (Rs 36,000/-) has to be made in advance at the time of admission as well as every year.

(ii) **Gymnasium.** Gymnasium has been installed in the college campus for students. Gym charges for Rs 600/- (i.e. Rs 50/- per month) is charged for its maint. The same will be paid in advance separately at the time of admission as well as every year.

(i) **AWES Insurance.** All students studying in AWES Colleges have been insured centrally by HQ AWES. The AWES Insurance premium for Rs 120/- per year required to be paid in advance by the candidate every year.

(ii) University Fee is required to be paid to KNR UHS at the time counselling, if the candidate selected for allotment of Provisional Admission order. University fee amount and mode of payment will be available in KNR UHS website. Hence, candidate has to prepare separate demand draft as specified in KNR UHS website.

27. **Refund of Fees** : Rules regarding refund of fees will be intimated to the candidates at the time of admission.

28. **Central Scheme to provide Interest Subsidy (CSIS) on Education Loan.** The Government of India has launched a scheme to provide full interest subsidy during the period i.e. course period plus one year or six months after getting job, whichever is earlier, on loans taken by students belonging to Economically Weaker Sections from scheduled banks under the Educational Loan Scheme of the Indian Bank's Association, for pursuing any of the approved courses of studies in technical and professional streams, from recognized institution in India. **For more details visit Ministry of HRD Website www.mhrd.gov.in.**

ACCIDENTS

29. The College authorities are taking all precautions for proper care of the students. However, the College will not be responsible for any unforeseen accident or death of the students during their training and stay at the College.

DISCIPLINE & SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR

30. (a) The discipline and good behavior of the students will be governed by the University and AWES regulations framed from time to time. The University empowers the College authorities to take disciplinary action including rustication of the students found indulging in any disciplinary act or Ragging. **Ragging in any form is banned and is a punishable offence. (Refer Appx`C').**

(b) In keeping with our rich and diverse Indian Culture, boys & girls are expected to behave in a mature manner.

LEGAL JURISDICTION

32. Any dispute regarding the terms and conditions of the admission, sale of prospectus, conduct of admission, course, fees, examination, promotion, pass marks, valuation of papers etc., concerning the Army College of Dental Sciences, Secunderabad shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the courts situated at Ranga Reddy District, Telangana only.

ARBITRATION

33. Any dispute concerning the interpretation of any of the terms and conditions of admission and any of the paragraphs of this prospectus or any dispute concerning the sale of prospectus, conduct of admission, course, fees, examination, attendance, pass marks, valuation of papers etc., shall be resolved amicably. If the student or any parent representing any minor student and the college fails to resolve the dispute amicably, the matter should be referred to the sole Arbitration of the Chairman or any other person(s) nominated by the Chairman.

34. The award passed by the sole Arbitrator shall be binding on both parties. The place of arbitration shall be at Secunderabad or the college premises only and the provisions of Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 shall apply to the arbitration proceedings. The courts situated at Secunderabad and Medchal District alone shall have the jurisdiction to entertain any application or litigation concerning the arbitration.

APPEAL

35 Any student aggrieved by any order or orders passed by any authority or authorities of Army College of Dental Sciences shall be entitled to prefer an appeal before the Managing Committee represented by the Member Secretary and Registrar within a period of 30 days from the date of any such order and the Member Secretary shall place the appeal before the Managing Committee for passing appropriate orders. The Managing Committee presided over by the Chairman may provide the right of hearing to the student or the parent and pass appropriate orders in the form of resolution and communicate the decision of the Managing Committee/ Appellate Authority. Unless and until the remedy of appeal is availed by the student/parent, the arbitration clause cannot be invoked. The Appellate Authority or Managing Committee shall have the jurisdiction to entertain appeal concerning any grievance of the student connected with payment of fees, disciplinary action taken by the college, punishment imposed in case of malpractice or any act of misconduct, attendance, pass marks, valuation of papers etc. Wherever the matter concerns the interpretation of rules, regulations, ordinances of Kaloji Narayana Rao University of Health Sciences, Warangal (Telangana), Universities Act, 1991 the Managing Committee/Appellate Authority shall have the right to direct the student(s)/parent(s) to Kaloji Narayana Rao University of Health Sciences, Warangal (Telangana) or any other authority or authorities for the relief prayed for.
